



Fall Festival Raffle Ticket Sale
For the purpose of
replacing windows, hallway carpet,
painting the sanctuary walls, & more!

Beginning on the weekend of August 18 & 19 and going through to October 20 & 21, we are asking all families of our church to sell a minimum of 10 raffle tickets. The cost of each ticket is \$20.

Ushers will pass-out the "Blue Raffle Ticket" envelopes during Masses this weekend. We ask that each family take one envelope.

For three Sundays, we will have extra "Blue Raffle Ticket" envelopes available after all Masses.

Members can also receive their envelope by coming to the church office during the week.

The cost of the renovation will be again around \$52,000. Renovation involves the replacement of windows in the social hall, offices, and classrooms in lower level, new carpet in hallways, narthex, and painting of the walls in the sanctuary and replacement of the black chairs in the social hall.

If we sell 3000 tickets, we will raise \$60,000. We have on hand 5,000 tickets. If we sell all 5,000 tickets, we will raise \$100,000.

The drawing of the winning raffle tickets will take place at 3:00 PM on Sunday, October 21 during the Fall Festival. You do not need to be present to win.

Prizes are 3rd place prize of \$500, 2nd place prize at \$1000 and Grand prize at \$4,000

If we sell 4000 tickets, we will add an additional prize of \$2,000 and if we sell all 5,000 tickets, we will add another Grand prize of \$4,000!

When you have sold your 10 tickets, you can drop the Raffle Ticket Envelope with the raffle ticket stubs & money in the offertory basket during Mass or drop the envelope with its contents in the mailbox located outside the mailroom – better known as the "dropbox". VERY IMPORTANT – please put your name on the blue envelope. We must write a receipt for each envelope turn-in. This is Archdiocese auditor directive.

If you can sell more the 10 tickets that would be deeply appreciated. You can receive more tickets by seeing the parishioners who are at the Raffle Ticket Table in the narthex of the church after Masses or Beth Andert at the church office.
