An important message from Archbishop Gregory Hartmeyer:

Today I wanted to take a moment to update you on the proposal to open a new Catholic school in Hall County. Despite our best efforts and all of the excitement surrounding the planned launch this fall, challenges have arisen that prevent us from opening the school as we had hoped.

The bishops and I understand that this news may be disappointing to many of you. The Catholic Schools Office, the archbishop's office, and the parishes in this area worked diligently to make this dream a reality, but we found that we need more time to lay the proper foundation for building a strong and sustainable Catholic school community. We believe this decision is in the best interest of our students, families, and parish communities.

I am very grateful for all the support you have given us up to this point. We will continue to work on other options for a school and we ask for your support and patience as we do so. We will keep you informed on what happens as this project progresses.
