# Types of Prayer



## Adoration

A prayer of PRAISE to God. Think of all the blessings he has given you and give thanks in your prayer.

### Example

I adore You, Jesus, my true life because You died for love of me. I adore You, Jesus, Divine Light because You show me the way to heaven. I adore You, Jesus, Divine Lamb, Who takes away the sin of the world.  
Amen



## Petition

A prayer of something you BELIEVE you need. You can also ask God for forgiveness in this prayer.

### Example

Please help me to do well on my test today.  
Amen

## Intercession

A prayer for SOMEONE else. If someone has asked you to pray for them or think of someone who needs your prayers.

### Example

I pray for my grandfather, help him to feel better.  
Amen

## Thanksgiving

Think of something you are GRATEFUL for and thank God for it.

### Example

Thank you God for my mom and dad and thank you for the dinner my mom prepared and for my dad who fixed my bike. Thank you for my brother who played soccer with me.  
Amen

### Example

Please help me to do well on my test today.

Amen

## Intercesión

Una oración por ALGUIEN más. Si alguien te ha pedido que ores por él o piensas en alguien que necesita tus oraciones.

### Ejemplo

Rezo por mi abuelo, ayúdalo a sentirse mejor.




